A. in Lifelong Learning and Extension The students pursuing any of the above two programs under the Department of Continuing Education & Extension are eligible to apply for the student exchange program.
Selection Criteria Student Mobility	Minimum Requirements: • Enrolment in one of the above-mentioned study programmes • English skills at the B2 level Ranking Criteria: • Study phase and fit to the study subject (students in higher semesters and students very close to the subject are selected with priority): 30% • Academic performance, volunteerism (students with very good academic performance and high level of voluntary commitment are prioritized): 40% • Demonstrated financial need: 30% (students with financial need will be prioritized) The Department followed all the criteria mentioned above.

Inclusion measurements	The following group of participants with fewer opportunities will be encouraged to apply for the programme: • Students in employment • Students with child(ren) • Students with special needs (in particular students with disabilities or chronic illnesses) • Socially disadvantaged students and students at risk of discrimination like equal chance to students representing various gender • Students with economic hurdles The criterion of “Economic Hurdles” is necessary for Delhi University. Students from these groups will be given priority in the selection process, if they are on the same rank as students without fewer opportunities.
