Recognition at Odesa I. I. Mechnikov National University	<p>Recognition of learning outcomes within academic cooperation with partner universities is carried out with using the European system of transfer and accumulation of ECTS credits. The legal base for Credit recognition at ONU is “Regulation on Academic Mobility” approved at ONU in 2022</p> <p>http://erasmus.onu.edu.ua/uk/normativni-materiali</p> <p>Recognition of credits has to be made by the faculty administrations upon the student’s claims. Students have to provide to the faculty 3 documents: Application form, Transcript of Records issued by Host University, Original Learning Agreement with Changes made during mobility period. Faculty compares courses from Transcript with ONU curricula and Learning agreement and issue Recognition Certificate for the Erasmus Office. Then gained Credits are imported into student’s record book and in the end mobility period recognized courses appear in the supplements of student’s diplomas. Erasmus office constantly monitors recognition process and help with difficult cases. In order to ensure more effective credit recognition procedures and to promote user-friendly and accessible processes for credit recognition with the aim of minimizing repeat study and facilitate efficient study pathways for learners, International office of ONU has elaborated a special “Regulation on Credit recognition” which was adopted on December 15th 2019.</p> <p>http://erasmus.onu.edu.ua/uk/normativni-materiali</p>
