PhD candidates (excluding final year) - Enrolment in one of the above-mentioned study programmes - English skills on the level B2 - Minimum 15 ECTS credits in the Learning Agreement. - Grade Point Average $\geq 80/100$. - Language proficiency \geq B2 (TOEFL, IELTS, TestDaF, or TSNUK certificate). <p>Ranking Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Study phase and fit of the study subject (students in higher semesters and students very close to the subject are selected with priority): 30% • Academic performance, volunteerism: 40% (students with very good academic performance and high volunteerism will be prioritized) • Demonstrated financial need: 30% (students with financial need will be prioritized)

Orphans and children deprived of parental care. 2. Children affected by the Chornobyl disaster or who lost a family member due to the Chornobyl disaster. 3. Children of miners. 4. Children whose parents are combatants. 5. Children of deceased participants in public protests. 6. Children of deceased combatants. 7. Internally displaced persons. 8. Children with disabilities. 9. Children from low-income families. <p>Students from these groups will be given priority in the selection process, if they are on the same rank as students without fewer opportunities.</p>

	<p><u>Recognition of Achievements:</u> all participants will have a signed Learning Agreement (for students) or Training Agreement (for staff) prior to the mobility period, clearly outlining the expected outcomes and recognizing their equivalence at the home institution.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <u>For students</u>, academic credits earned at the host institution will be fully recognized and transferred (where possible) in accordance with the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS). Participants will receive certificates or transcripts from the host institution confirming their successful participation and achievements. <p>The students submit their Transcripts of Records and Learning Agreements to their Faculty Coordinators and the Department of Academic Mobility.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Staff participation will be acknowledged through official certification and integration of mobility outcomes into professional development plans. <p><u>Reporting Procedures:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Participants' Reporting: - Students and staff will be required to submit a detailed report on their mobility experience, including academic, cultural, and logistical aspects. - Feedback will be collected via surveys and interviews to assess the quality of the mobility experience. - Key findings and success stories will be shared with institutional stakeholders and through public channels to promote the mobility program.
