Recognition at For undergraduate degree programs, TXST is based on a **Texas State** semester credit hour system. A semester credit hour is defined University as a unit of measure of instruction consisting of 60 minutes, of which 50 minutes must be direct faculty instruction, and two hours of out-of-class work over a 15-week period. For example, one semester credit hour courses should contain 15 classroom or direct instructional hours and 30 hours of out-of-class student work. Grades are assigned on an A-F scale (e.g., A=excellent, B=good, C=average, D=passing, and F=failing) (https://www.registrar.txst.edu/our-services/grades.html). Course content is evaluated by TXST faculty to be evaluated as a direct equivalent to a TXST course. Courses that are not directly equivalent to a TXST course, but are deemed transferable, are recorded as elective hours. For graduate degree programs, TXST is based on a semester credit hour system. A semester credit hour is defined as a unit of measure of instruction consisting of 60 minutes, but 50 minutes must be direct instruction over a 15-week period in a semester system. Credit hours must be presented in whole numbers. For each direct instructional hour students are also expected to complete minimally 30 hours of out-of-class work. Grades are assigned on an A-F scale (e.g., A=excellent, B=good, C=passing for master's students but below passing for doctoral students, D=below passing, F=failing). (https://www.registrar.txst.edu/our-services/grades.html) Course content is evaluated by TXST faculty to determine equivalency with TXST courses. TXST students in education who complete approved courses at Julius-Maximilians-Universität Würzburg will be awarded transfer credit through application to and approval of the Dean
