Recognition at University of Sarajevo	During the <i>During the Mobility</i> phase of the Learning Agreement, students are required to communicate with each professor responsible for the courses listed in Table B of the Learning Agreement (in the <i>Before/During the Mobility</i> section) to request confirmation that the courses – if passed – will be recognised. In adherence to the Erasmus European Charter for Higher Education and the Mobility Guide of the University of Sarajevo, academics are encouraged to uphold the principle of flexibility regarding the equivalence and similarity between their courses and those offered at the partner institution.

	Upon obtaining the Transcript of Records from the partner university, students are required to translate the document and submit it to the Student Service at the Faculty. The International Relations Office and the Vice-Dean formalize the recognition process by preparing Table D – <i>After the Mobility and</i> documenting the successfully completed exams based on the Transcript of Records as well as the <i>Learning/During the Mobility</i> document. Any exams that cannot be recognized, or participation in summer schools, are added to the Diploma Supplement as free elective subjects.
